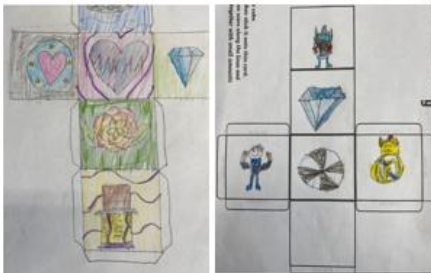


We are a Right Respecting School and this statement supports the following articles from the UN Convention on the Rights of a Child

Year 4, Spring Term Shell Structures



Year 4 investigated a range of nets and then designed our own. The brief was to design and make a gift box.



We used Computer Aided Design software (Tinkercad) to view our products in 3D and used Google to add images to our final 3D nets, using Microsoft Word. We printed our designs on A3 paper.



We selected a range of materials such as scissors, special card, paper and PVA glue to make our gift boxes.



Finally, we folded our nets to make a rigid gift box with a functioning lid and space to hold a present inside, then evaluated our products against the brief.
