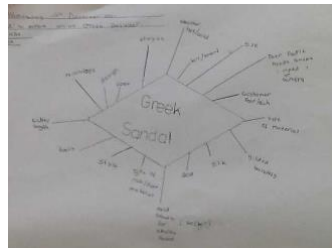
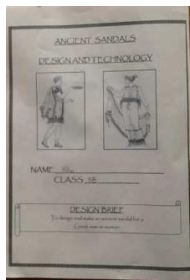
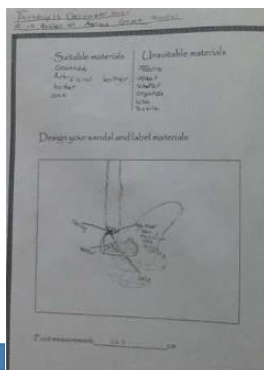
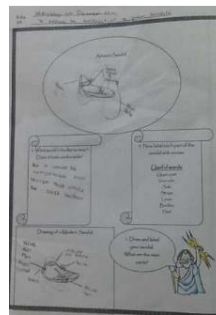
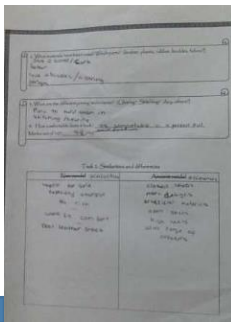


We are a Right Respecting School and this statement supports the following articles from the UN Convention on the Rights of a Child
