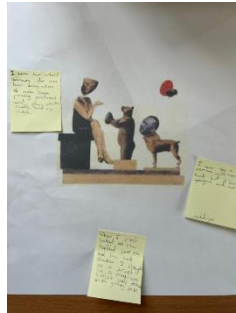
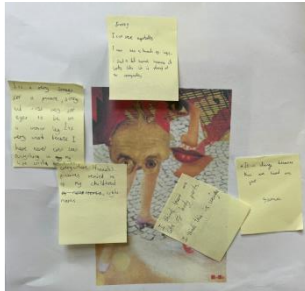


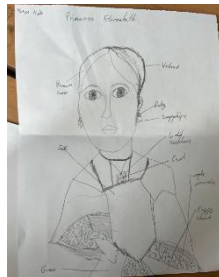
We are a Right Respecting School and this statement supports the following articles from the UN Convention on the Rights of a Child

Year 4 researched and responded to the work of collage artist Hannah Hoch.

We used different types of materials such as tissue paper, cellophane and scrap paper first to experiment with different textures and layering.
