Every child must be free to say what they think and to seek and receive information of any kind as long as it is within the law.

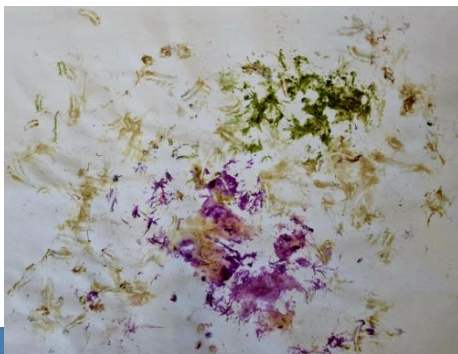
Year 5, Spring Term Printing
