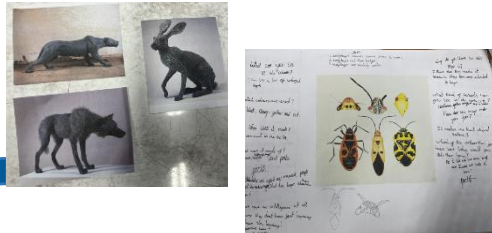
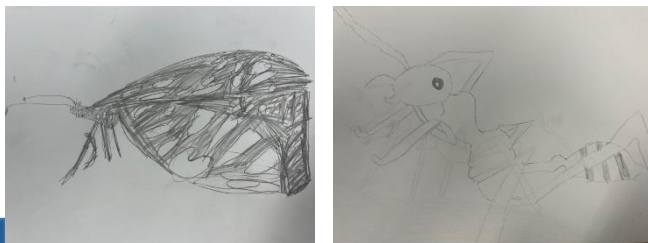


We are a Right Respecting School and this statement supports the following articles from the UN Convention on the Rights of a Child

Year 4, Autumn Term 3D Insect Sculptures



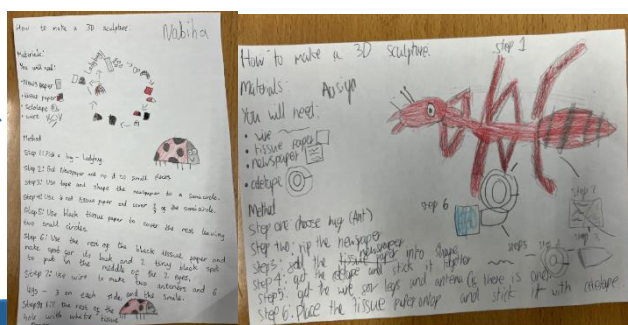
Year 4 researched and responded to the works of different artists that had created sculptures, such as Kendra Haste and Emile Galle.
